LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS (LPG) TESTING

As the uptake of Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) increases, the Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC) is keen to ensure that LPG sold in the market meets local and international standards thereby enhancing safety during use.

Accordingly, ERC has acquired two (2) LPG testing equipment that will be hosted at Kenya Bureau of Standards (KEBS) laboratories in Nairobi and Mombasa.

Traders involved in the import of LPG are hereby notified that with effect from 1st November 2018, all imports of LPG shall be subjected to testing to check conformity to Kenyan standards before entry into the country .

Similarly, in order to further enhance safety in the LPG sector, ERC has put in place the following regulatory measures:

- i. Revision of the Energy (Liquefied Petroleum Gas) Regulations to enhance penalties for malpractices.
- ii. Regular audits of refilling plants to ensure continued conformity to standards and compliance to set laws.
- iii. Setting up of a dedicated enforcement team to continuously check for malpractices in the sector.
