

PUBLIC NOTICE ON STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT ON THE DRAFT PETROLEUM (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2025

The State Department for Petroleum, Ministry of Energy and Petroleum is responsible for policy making, oversight and coordination of the petroleum sector, in addition to the functions and powers assigned to it in the Petroleum Act, Cap. 308 and Energy Act, Cap. 314, and Executive Orders.

The Cabinet Secretary directed that the petroleum legal and regulatory framework be reviewed with the objective of supporting Kenya's First Petroleum Licensing Round (under the Act) planned for 2025 and to align the framework with best petroleum industry practice.

Consequently, the **Draft Petroleum (Amendment) Bill, 2025** (the Draft Bill) has been developed. The Draft Bill can be accessed on the State Departments' website: https://petroleum.go.ke/downloads.
