

Licence Application Guide Export and Wholesale of LPG in Bulk

New Licence Application requirements

- 1. Certificate of Incorporation / Business Registration Certificate;
- 2. CR12 from the Registrar of companies (should not be older than 1 year at the time of submission of the application. Further, if a Limited company appears as part of the shareholders, provide the company's CR12 plus all the Directors' IDs);
- 3. Legible Copies of Identification Documents (*IDs/Passports for all the directors*);
- 4. Valid Work Permits Class "G" for all foreign directors working in Kenya (Foreign directors not resident in Kenya should provide a notarized declaration. Further, any employee given Powers of Attorney by a foreign director should provide a copy of their identification document);
- 5. A valid Tax Compliance Certificate for the applicant from the Kenya Revenue Authority;
- 6. A valid Single Business Permit for the premises of operation from the respective County Government;
- 7. Proof of presence in the Kenyan market by submitting a scan of either:
 - a) A valid licence for Import, Export and Wholesale of LPG; or
 - b) A supply agreement with a holder of a valid licence for Import, Export and Wholesale of LPG.

Licence application procedure

To apply, visit the Online Services Portal on the EPRA website and follow the following steps:

- 1. Click "Create Account";
- 2. Click on "License Management" then select "New Licence Application";
- 3. Select the preferred Category in this case Export and Wholesale of LPG in Bulk;
- 4. Read and accept the licence conditions provided and click on "Proceed with registration icon";
- 5. Follow the application process step by step by filling in the required information and click "Save";
- 6. Attach the required documents as per the licence category; and
- 7. Submit the application.



Licence Application Guide Export and Wholesale of LPG in Bulk

a) Licence Renewal Requirements:

- 1. *CR12* from the Registrar of companies (should not be older than 1 year at the time of submission of the application. Further, if a Limited company appears as part of the shareholders, provide the company's CR12 plus all the Directors' IDs);
- 2. Legible Copies of Identification Documents (*IDs/Passports for all the directors*);
- 3. Valid Work Permits Class "G" for all foreign directors working in Kenya (Foreign directors not resident in Kenya should provide a notarized declaration. Further, any employee given Powers of Attorney by a foreign director should provide a copy of their identification document);
- 4. A valid Tax Compliance Certificate for the applicant from the Kenya Revenue Authority;

- 6. Proof of presence in the Kenyan market by submitting a scan of either:
 - c) A valid licence for Import, Export and Wholesale of LPG; or
 - d) A supply agreement with a holder of a valid licence for Import, Export and Wholesale of LPG.

Licence Processing period, validity and charges

- 1. Licence applications are evaluated within 30 calendar days from date of receipt.
- 2. No fees are charged for Petroleum Road Tanker Driver Certificates issued by EPRA.
- 3. To track the status of a licence applications, dial the short code *363# or send a short message with the word 'license' and the 'application reference number' to 40850 or log into the online licensing portal www.epra.go.ke/portal.
- 4. Once approvals have been granted, licencees can download and print the license at their convenience.
