

## Licence Application Guide Storage and Wholesale of LPG in Cylinders

## Licence application requirements

- 1. Certificate of Incorporation / Business Registration Certificate;
- 2. CR12 from the Registrar of companies (should not be older than 1 year at the time of submission of the application. Further, if a Limited company appears as part of the shareholders, provide the company's CR12 plus all the Directors' IDs);
- 3. Legible Copies of Identification Documents (IDs/Passports for all the directors);
- 4. Valid Work Permits Class "G" for all foreign directors working in Kenya (Foreign directors not resident in Kenya should provide a notarized declaration. Further, any employee given Powers of Attorney by a foreign director should provide a copy of their identification document);
- 5. A valid Tax Compliance Certificate for the applicant from the Kenya Revenue Authority;
- 6. A valid Single Business Permit for the premises of operation from the respective County Government;
- 7. Proof of ownership of at least 5,000 cylinders of either 0.5,1,3,6 or 13kg or a written authority for distributorship of a particular brand from a licensed LPG cylinder brand owner;
- 8. Proof of registration of the LPG cylinder brand by the body responsible for brand registration in Kenya;
- 9. Proof of ownership or lease of a yard or warehouse as premises of operation;
- 10. A valid Fire Clearance Certificate for the premises from the respective County Government;
- 11. A valid certificate of registration of the premises as a work place from the Directorate of Occupational Safety and Health Services; and
- 12. A valid certificate of weighing scale calibration from the Department of Weights and Measures.

# Licence application procedure:

To apply, visit the Online Services Portal on the EPRA website and follow the following steps:

- 1. Click "Create Account";
- 2. Click on "License Management" then select "New Licence Application";
- 3. Select the preferred Category in this case *Storage and Wholesale of LPG in Cylinders;*

- 4. Read and accept the licence conditions provided and click on "*Proceed with registration icon*";
- 5. Follow the application process step by step by filling in the required information and click *"Save"*;
- 6. Attach the required documents as per the licence category; and
- 7. Submit the application.

## Licence Renewal Requirements:

- 1. Licence applications are evaluated within 30 calendar days from date of receipt.
- 2. No fees are charged for Petroleum Business Licences issued by EPRA.
